PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Rural Health Association of Tennessee (RHA) invites proposals from qualified individuals and/or organizations to develop and design a Rural Age Friendly Report. The purpose of the report is to share relevant health and social needs data related to older adults in rural Tennessee, feature persons and communities who have “Age Friendly” services and programs, and policy recommendations, if relevant.

Rural Health Association of Tennessee has collected nominations for Rural Age Friendly Awards that will serve as success stories and replicable practices to be featured in the report.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

- Apx. 1-hour Project Kick Off meeting with RHA staff.
- Develop the content for the following for approval by RHA:
 - Report introduction
 - Overview of the Age Friendly Movement and Purpose
 - Overview of access to healthcare and social services in Tennessee and implications on older adults.
 - Success story features (we have 9 awards)
 - Summary policy recommendations
- Once the content is agreed upon, draft a design for publication similar to RHA’s [Workforce Ready Report](#).
- Provide RHA with all raw materials and assets, including a printer friendly final report.
